Registration for 2008 Summer Softball Leagues

Age Categories

10U ■ 12U ■ 14U ■ 16U ■ 18U

- **A player's age on December 31, 2007 determines the age division in which they are eligible to participate during the 2008 season**
- IGFA will offer teams in each age category for the summer season running May into July. All players should reside within the Mounds View School District.

General Information:

- Registration deadline is March 1st, 2008, registrations received by March 1st will be given priority.
- Teams will be limited to 12-14 girls per team with the number of teams to be determined by the availability of coaches. If the number of registrations within an age bracket warrants more than one team, player skill evaluations will be used to determine what team she plays on.
- Player skill evaluations, if necessary, will be held in early March. Players will be contacted regarding the dates and times.
- Players will be contacted by their coach in early April with team, practice, and game information.
- Players must furnish their own sliding shorts, glove, and softball shoes. Players 12U through 18U must purchase their uniform, the association will make a one time \$30 contribution towards a player's uniform. 10U uniforms are provided by the association.
- League games usually are played once or twice per week in the evenings. Schedules will be announced. Each league game consists of 2-five inning games beginning at 6:15pm.
- Weekend tournaments will be scheduled at the discretion of the coach. Registration fees for all age brackets include tournament fees.

Registration Fees (Per Player*): \$200.00 (12U-18U) (includes 2 tournaments)
\$150.00 (10U) (includes up to 2 tournaments)

***Discounts are given for multiple players from the same family. Fees are reduced by \$75 for each additional player accompanying a registered player from the same immediate family. Non-discounted registration fee will be required from the oldest registered player according to the above fee schedule.**

WAIVER / MEDICAL RELEASE

Fast pitch softball is a very fun and enjoyable game, however, injuries can and do occur. This warning IS NOT intended to scare players and parents, or to infer that softball is an unusually dangerous sport. The intent is to meet the "Detailed and Thorough" criteria required by the courts. The courts now require a "Thorough Warning" be given in order to receive INFORMED CONSENT TO PARTICIPATE. Fast pitch softball includes (but not limited to) typical activities of throwing hard balls, swinging metal bats, running, sliding, and catching. These activities take place during the hot summer weather and every conceivable injury or accident associated with these activities is possible. Some of those injuries include cuts, scrapes, blister, various head and neck injuries, nose bleeds, jammed fingers, dislocations, broken bones, eye injuries, heat stroke, and knee & ankle injuries. There is always the possibility of a freak accident that might lead to serious injury and possibly death.

I/We as parents/guardians of the above named player, hereby give permission to the above named player to participate in Irondale Girls Fast Pitch Association activities. I/We as parents or guardians acknowledge the risk of injury and assume all risks incidental to participation in Irondale Girls Fast Pitch Association including transportation to and from activities and functions. Further, I/We hereby waive, release, indemnify and agree to hold harmless the Irondale Girls Fast Pitch Association, its officers, directors, program directors, sponsors, organizers, supervisors, coaches, participants, and any other individual associated with Irondale Girls Fast Pitch Association for any claim arising out of any injury or harm to my/our child or me/ourselves.

In case of emergency, I/We authorize a physician, surgeon, or dentist to exercise their professional judgment and assess the risks and choose the necessary treatment as they in their professional judgment determine to be necessary for the health and safety of my/our child.

I/We understand the risks of participating in Fast Pitch Softball and as parent or legal guardian of the above named player give my/our informed consent to participate.
